

1 1/2" Strap Directions

Application to fenders

- Insert the loop end of the strap through the eyelet hole of the fender
- Insert the opposite end of the strap through the loop and cinch up tight on the fender
 - Tips 1) Make sure there are no twists in the strap so it will lay flat when cinched tight to the fender
 - 2) Insert the strap through the loop from the side with a seam so it will lay flat when cinched tight to the fender
- From the back side slip the strap end through the bottom slot of the cam buckle (the slot farthest from the pivot point of the buckle) then back through the top slot



Use

- Slide the cam buckle up or down on the strap to adjust the height of the fender
- When you have the strap at your desired length slip the end of the strap around the rail, cleat, stanchion, or lifeline in your desired location and feed the end of the strap back through the cam buckle
- Pull up tight so that the cam buckle is forming a loop tight around the rail, cleat, stanchion, or lifeline
- Close the cam buckle to lock in place
